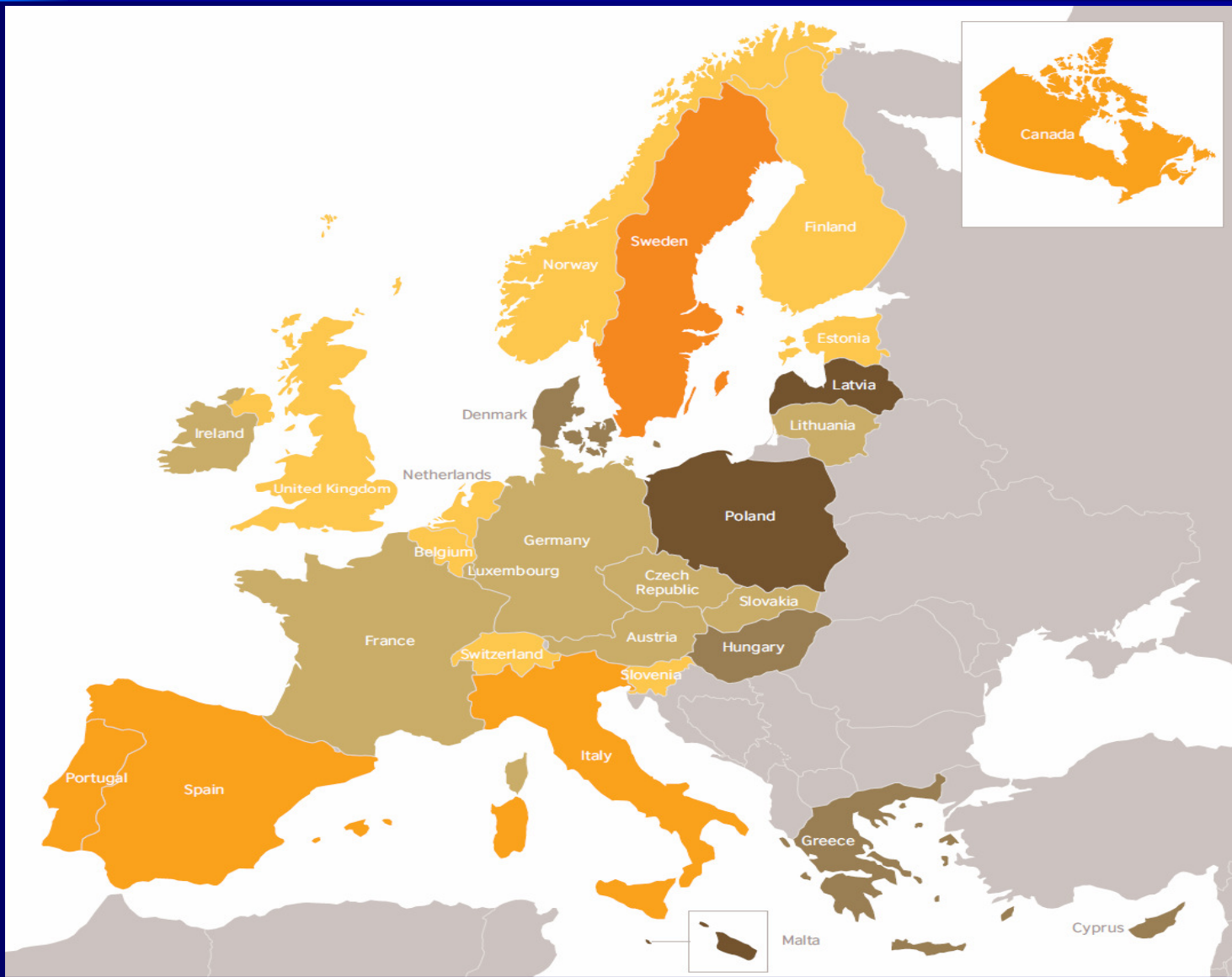
The Contextual Framework: Integration Policy

- Hungarian partner: Menedék

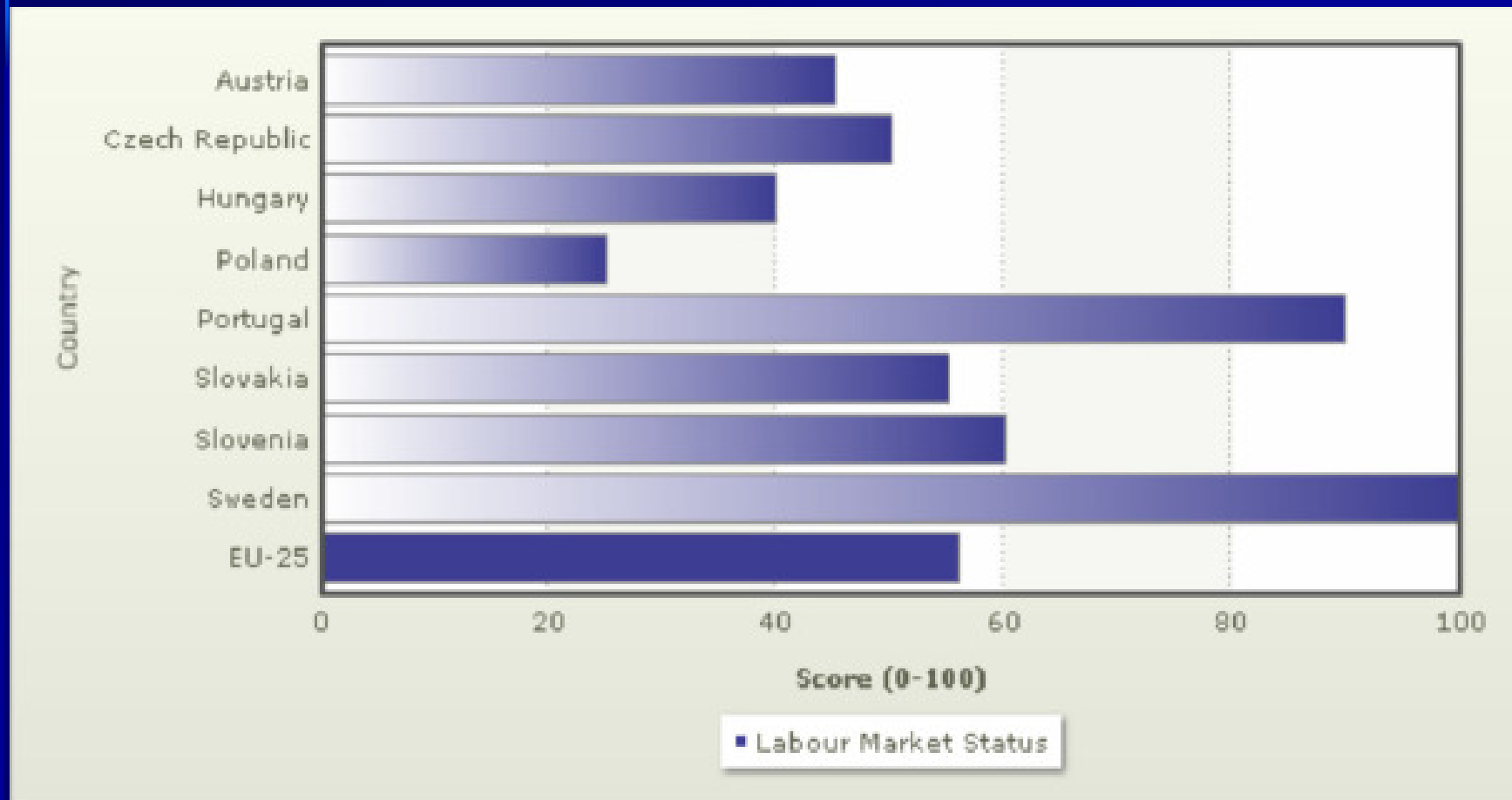

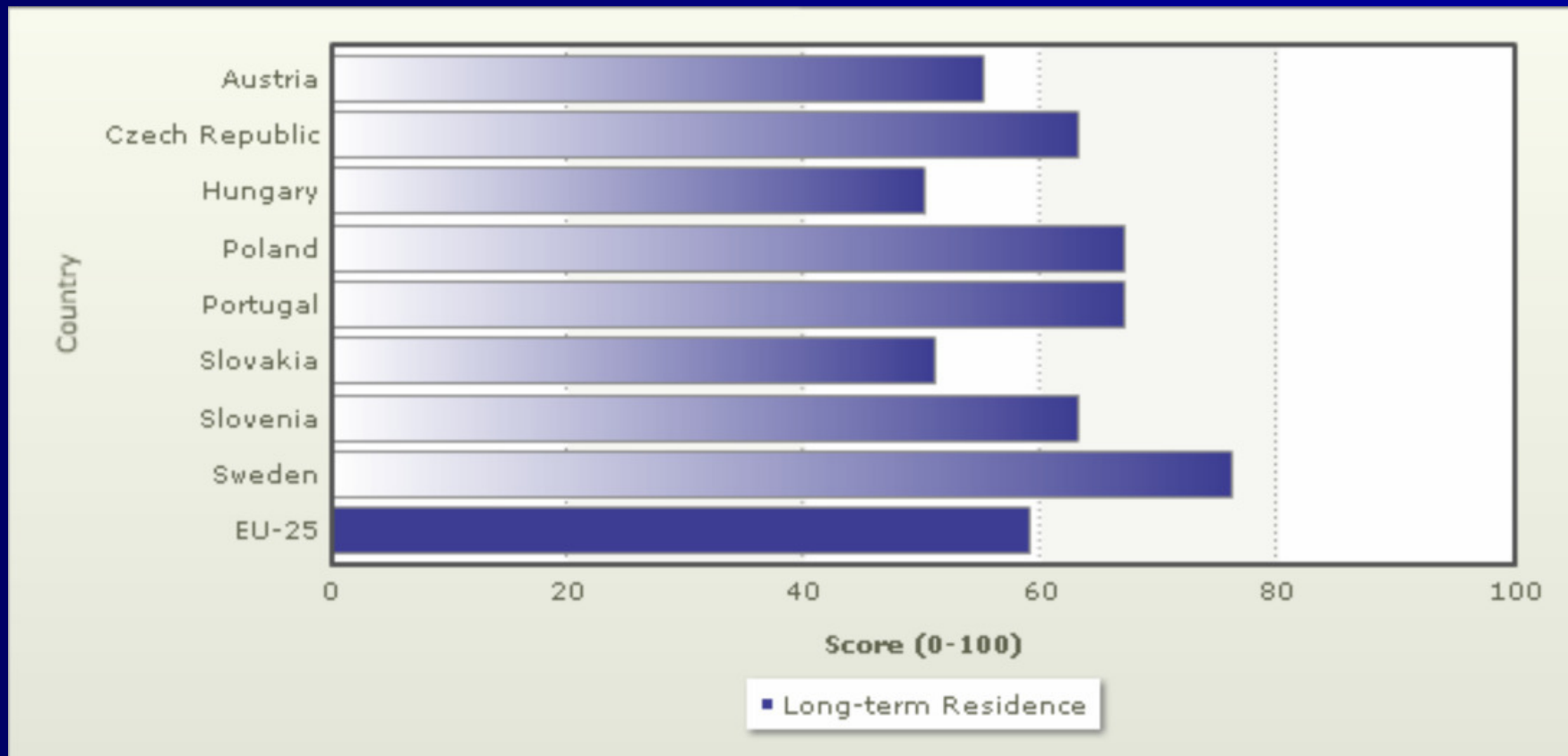
Comparison of MIPEx Countries



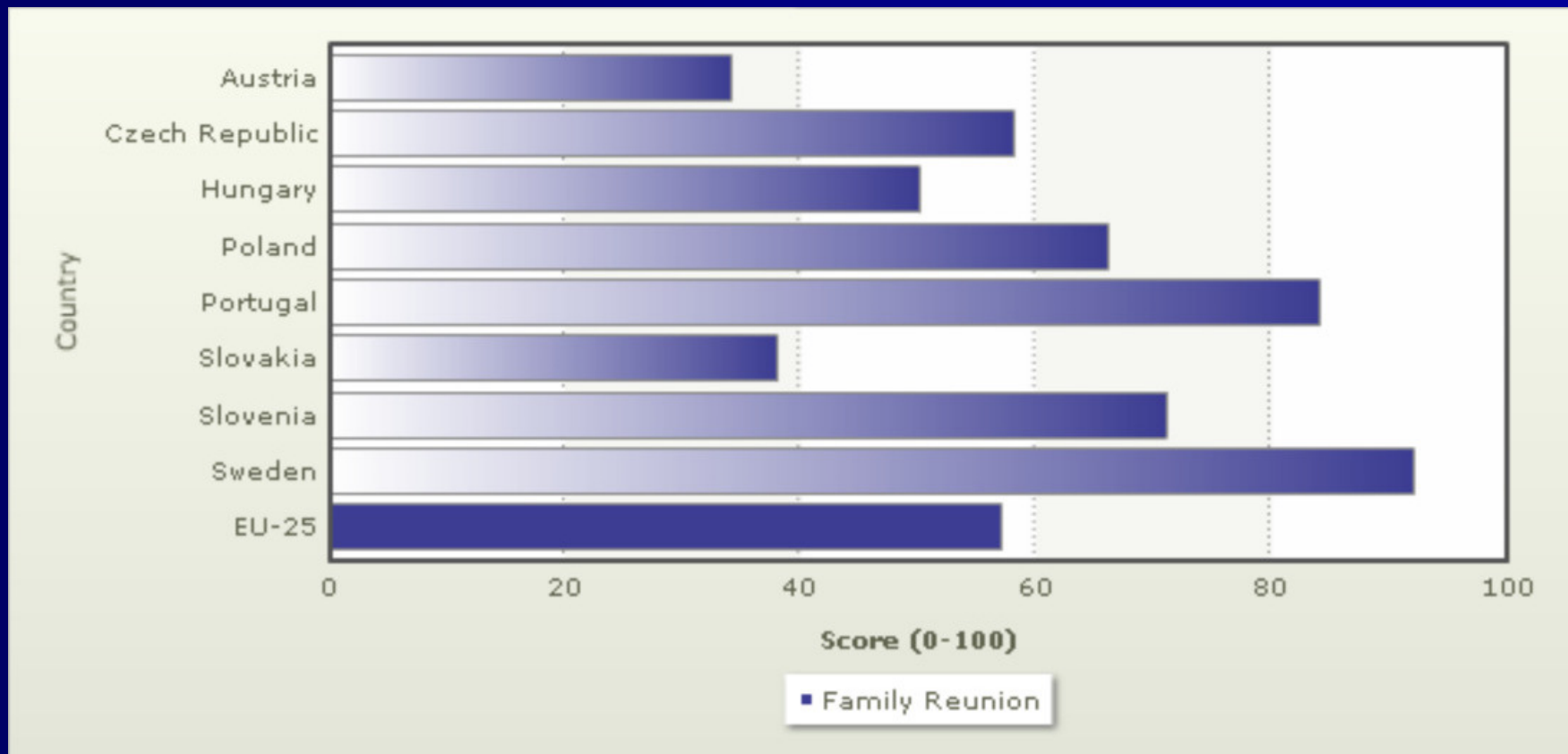
Access to the Labour Market



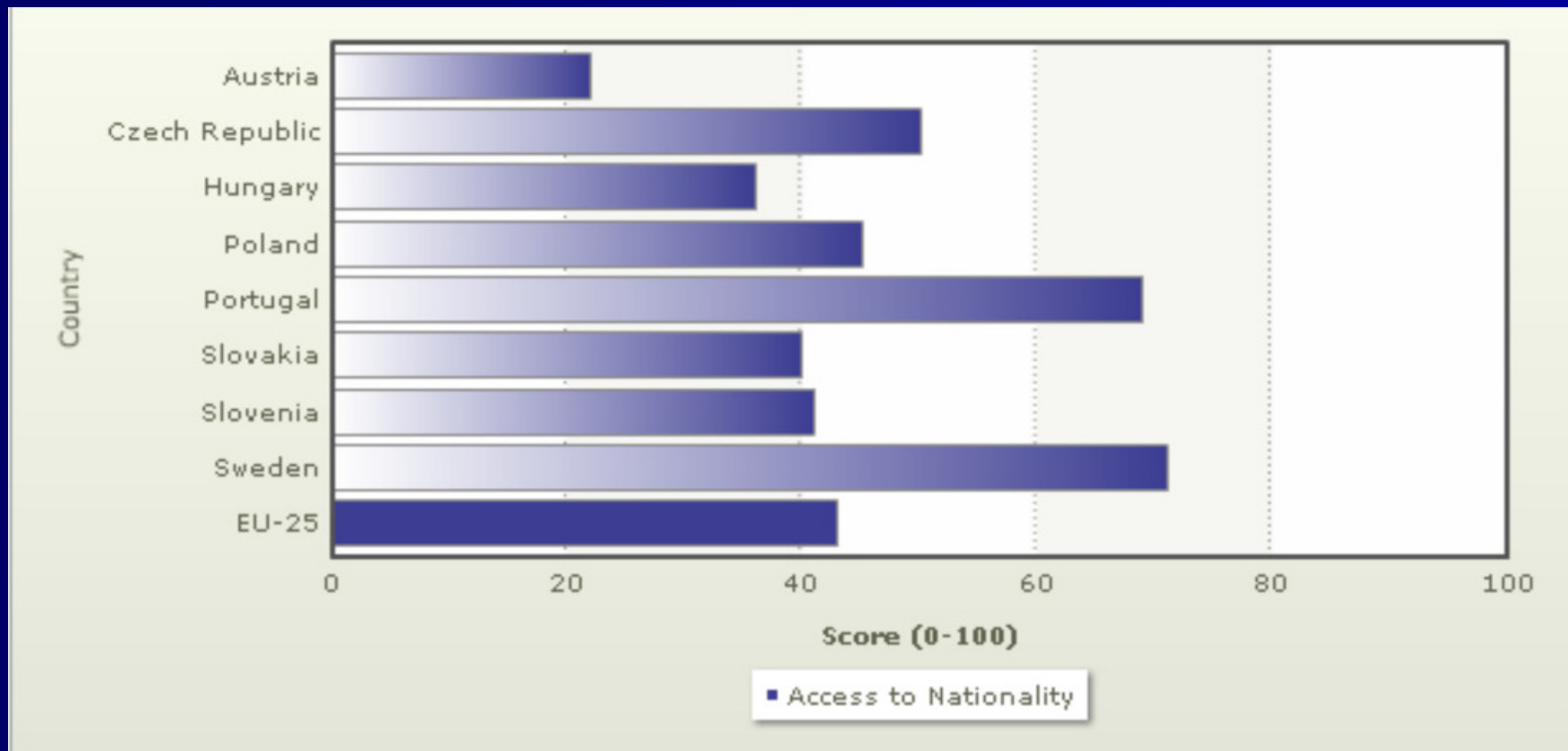
Long-term Residence



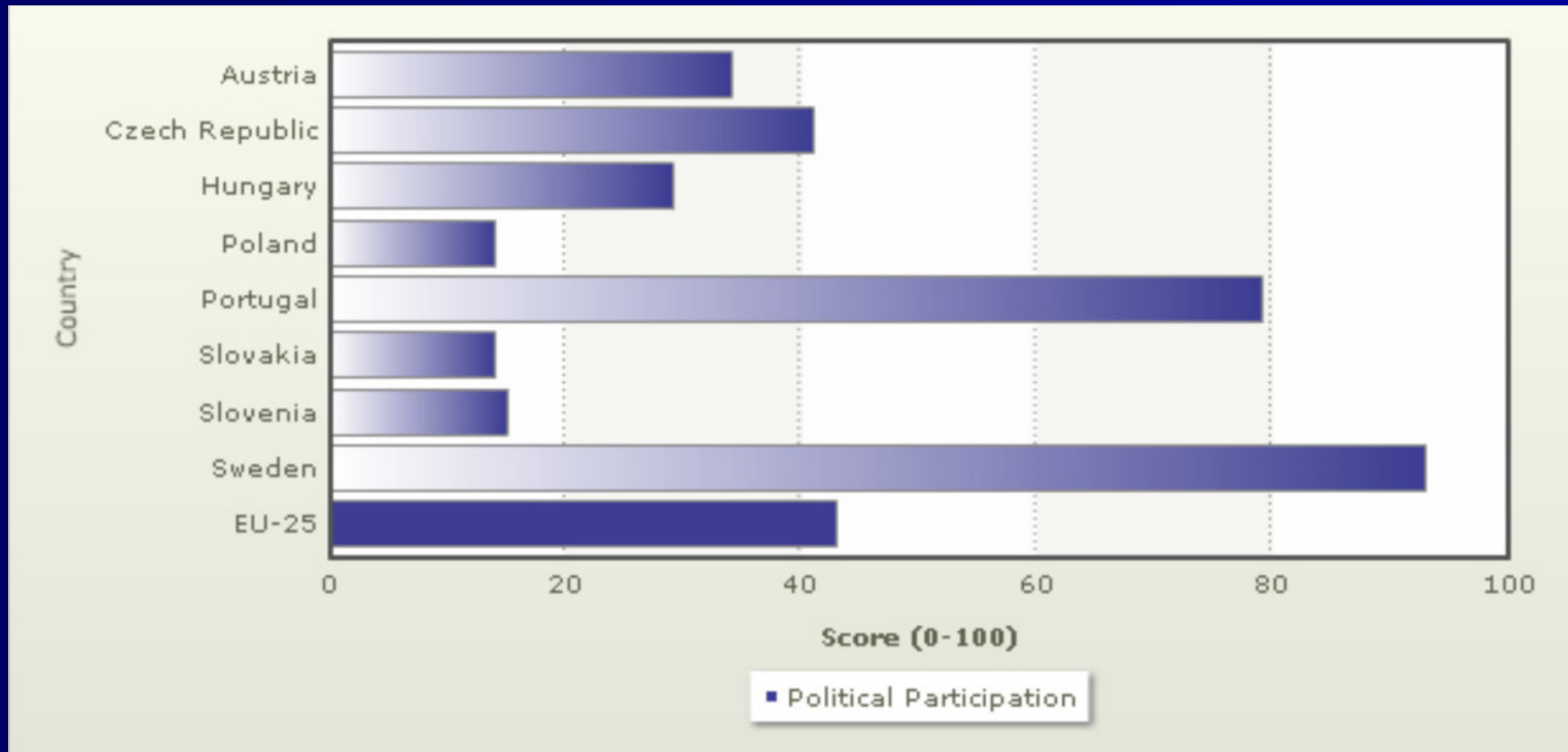
Family Reunion



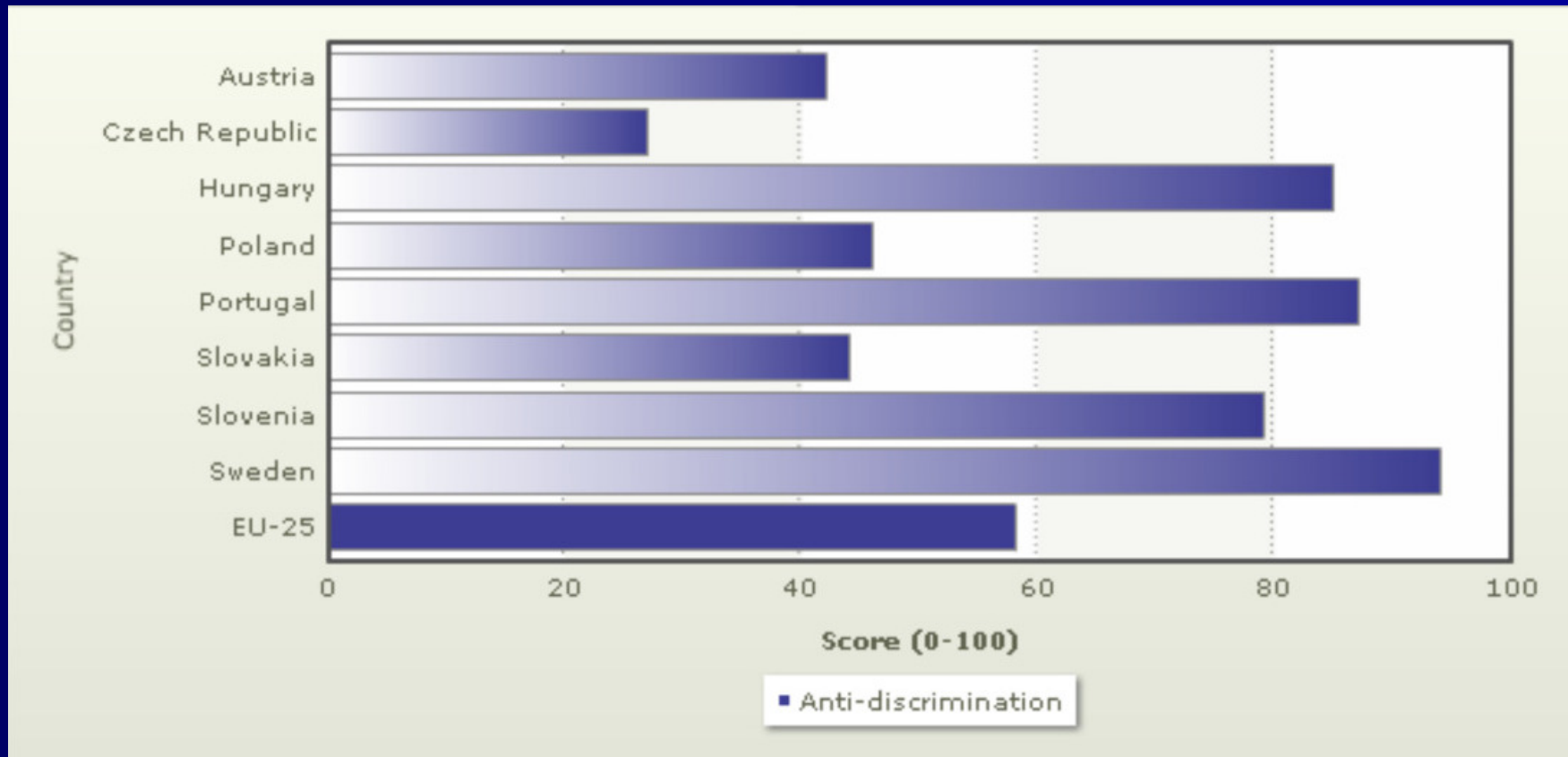
Access to Nationality
